Referee Payment Guidelines

- A) If a game is scheduled to be played and is not going to be played as scheduled, as long as the center referee and assignor are notified by the league deadline or, in the absence of other league guidance, 24 hrs in advance, referees will NOT be reimbursed by the league. It will be the duty of the Local Assignor, club assignor, to notify the ARs for that game is not being played.
- B) If there is a day of cancellation for weather conditions/poor field conditions, etc., the referee does not get paid. If the referee arrives for the match and the match does not begin due to weather or field conditions, the referee receives pay for one half of one game by the City.
- C) If the referees arrive for the match and a team does not show, a team does not have enough players OR passes are not present, the match is not played and the referees are paid in full. The center referee will submit a report to the league and the team who failed to follow through is responsible for referee payment.
 - *Referees will not collect cash from the players. The City of Charleston will send payment to the Assignor for the referees.
- D) If the referees arrive for the match and it starts but has to be abandoned before the first half is concluded (weather, field condition, etc.) and the match cannot be finished following a reasonable delay, the referees receive half game pay by the City. Cash will be given back to teams and the City of Charleston will send payment to the assignor for referees.

 *Matches that are terminated before the first half is over will be rescheduled and start the match from where it was terminated. If the same referee is able to be assigned for the rescheduled game, they should be assigned that game and will then receive the cash payment from the teams for that game and not paid an additional game by the City. (If a different referee is assigned for the rescheduled game, they will receive the full cash payment from the teams.)
