Prior to each match, the teams shall present a GotSport Game Card to the Referee, which shall serve as the Official Game Card prior to the game and the official Match Report following the completion of the game. The Referee shall use the GotSport Game Card to check in the players from both teams.

Following the completion of each match, the Referee shall accurately record all scores and cards issued onto the GotSport Game Card (now the official Match Report). Once the scores and cards issued are written on the Match Report, it should be presented to both coaches for their signature. Each team is required to take a picture of the final Match Report for their own records.

If a player is sent off for Violent Conduct, Spitting, or Abusive Language, a U.S. Soccer Supplemental Report must be filled out and submitted to the referee assignor with a copy of the Match Report. Additionally, a U.S. Soccer Supplemental Report must be filled out and submitted to the referee assignor for situations involving Referee Abuse or Referee Assault. The referee assignor shall submit all U.S. Soccer Supplemental Reports and corresponding Match Report to the League Manager.
